Bloody Fields of Flanders/Freedom Come All Ye, Trip to Tiree, Prince of Wales, Ale is Dear, and Clean Pea Strae:

Bloody Fields of Flanders/Freedom Come All Ye':

First A: Marcia plays ONE A only, very quiet, very reflective, with piano.

Freedom Come All Ye: Dale immediately comes in

1st verse, unaccompanied.
2nd verse, bass enters, and soft drone
3rd verse: Flora and Judith accompany Dale on harmony parts.

Retreat march Bloody Fields of Flanders- up tempo, don't drag! Some harmony players would

be great on this! *B part*: Watch for theme that repeats 3 times: 1st: moderate loud 2nd: VERY soft 3rd: come back STRONG for strong finish

<u>**Trip to Tiree</u>**- Watch Marcia for cues- pick up notes will be slower, then right into tune, ABCD, no parts repeated</u>

<u>Prince of Wales</u>- Two times through. First time with piano Second time, piano drops out, and- SOME Fiddlers play 2nd part. Listen to each other to stay together.

<u>Ale is Dear</u>: Piano back in! 2 times straight through *** CUT the very last note of the Ale is Dear, and go to pick-up note of A, into Clean Pea

<u>Clean Pea Strae:</u> TWO time straight through, and end with only ONE D
